# Translation of Great Domesday Book Folio 205v

### HUNTINGDONSHIRE

## X. THE LAND OF THE COUNT OF EU

In BUCKWORTH Tosti had 10 hides to the geld. [There is] land for 18 ploughs. This was a BEREWICK of Great Paxton. Now the Count of EU holds it; and has 2 ploughs in demesne there, on 2 hides of this land; and 16 villans having 10 ploughs, and 1 smith having 5 acres of this land. There is a priest and a church, to which half a hide of this land belongs, with 2 villans and 1 plough. There are 80 acres of meadow and 30 acres of scrubland. TRE, as now, worth 10l. A knight holds 2 ½ hides of this land, and has there 4 villans and 1 bordar with 5 ploughs. It is worth 3l.

### XI. THE LAND OF EARL HUGH

In **UPTON** Edgar had 4 hides to the geld, with sake and soke. [There is] land for 6 ploughs. There are now 2 ploughs in demesne, on 1 hide of this land; and 14 villans and 5 bordars having 8 ploughs. There is a church and a priest, and 1 mill [rendering] 3s, and 50 acres of meadow. TRE worth 4l; now 5l. Fulcui holds it of Earl Hugh.

In **COPPINGFORD** Edgar had 4 hides to the geld, with sake and soke. [There is] land for 5 ploughs. There is now 1 plough in demesne, on half a hide of this land; and 14 villans and 2 bordars have 3 ploughs. There is a church and a priest. TRE, as now, worth 4l. Humphrey holds it of Earl Hugh.

## XII. THE LAND OF WALTER GIFFARD

In FOLKSWORTH Ketilbert had 5 hides to the geld. [There is] land for 5 ploughs. There is now 1 plough in demesne; and 17 villans and 5 bordars with 7 ploughs. There are 20 acres of meadow, [and] woodland pasture 6 furlongs long and 2 furlongs and 6 perches broad. TRE worth 100s; now 4l. Hugh holds it of Walter Giffard.

### XIII. THE LAND OF WILLIAM DE WARENNE

In **KIMBOLTON** Earl Harold had 10 hides to the geld. [There is] land for 20 ploughs. William de Warenne holds it now, and has in demesne there 5 ploughs, on 5 hides; and 84 villans and 36 bordars with 25 ploughs. There is a priest and a church, and 70 acres of meadow, and woodland pasture 1 league long and 1 league broad. There is 1 mill [rendering] 5s. TRE worth 7l; now 16l4s. 2 knights have 1 hide of this land, and have 1 plough and 5 oxen there. It is worth 20s.

S In Keysoe [Beds.] Ællic [had] 3 virgates of land to the geld. [There is] land for 6 oxen. SOKELAND.

There is 1 sokeman and 7 bordars, and 4 acres of meadow and 50 acres of woodland pasture.

S In Swineshead [Beds.], 3 ½ hides to the geld. [There is] land for 4 ploughs. SOKELAND. There is now 1 sokeman and 7 villans and 5 bordars, and 16 acres of meadow, [and] woodland pasture 1 league long and 4 furlongs broad. It is worth 40s. Eustace holds it of William.

S In Catworth, 1 hide to the geld. [There is] land for 1 plough. SOKELAND. Eustace holds it of William, and has half a plough there, and 1 bordar with 1 ox, and 1 acre of meadow and 6 acres of scrubland. It is worth 20s.

S In another Catworth [Little Catworth], 1 hide to the geld. [There is] land for 1 plough. SOKELAND. Now Thorth holds it of William, and has 1 plough there, and 1 bordar, and 12 acres of meadow. It is worth 30s. All this SOKELAND belongs to Kimbolton.

### XIIII. THE LAND OF HUGH DE BOLBEC

#### NORMANCROSS HUNDRED

In **WOODWALTON** Saxi had 5 hides to the geld. [There is] land for 7 ploughs. There are now 2 ploughs in demesne, on 1 hide of this land; and 19 villans having 4 ploughs. There is a church, and 16 acres of meadow, [and] woodland pasture 16 furlongs long and 6 furlongs and 2 virgates broad. TRE, as now, worth 100s. Hugh de Bolbec holds it of Earl William.

## XV. THE LAND OF EUDO FITZHUBERT

In **HAMERTON** Wulfheah had 15 carucates hides [sic] of land to the geld. Eudo the Steward has them now of the king, and Ællic and Leofwine [had] 3 hides [of which] the SOKE [was] in 'Leightonstone' Hundred. Eudo has this land, and the king has the soke. Now in the manor there are 4 ploughs in demesne, on 3 hides of this land; and 26 villans having 6 ploughs. There are 60 acres of meadow and 10 acres of scrubland. 2 knights hold 2 hides of this land, and have 2 ploughs there. The whole of this manor was worth 12l TRE; now the same.

### XVI. THE LAND OF SWEIN OF ESSEX

#### TOSELAND HUNDRED

In WARESLEY Robert fitzWimarc had 7 hides to the geld. [There is] land for 9 ploughs. There are now 2 ploughs in demesne; and 17 villans and 4 bordars with 2 ploughs. There are 25 acres of meadow and 16 acres of scrubland. TRE worth 8I; now 6I. Turold holds it of Swein of Essex.

## XVII. THE LAND OF ROGER D'IVRY

### 'LEIGHTONSTONE' HUNDRED

In **COVINGTON** Eskil had 8 ½ hides to the geld. [There is] land for 13 ploughs. There are now 3 ploughs in demesne, on half a hide of this land; and 18 villans having 8 ploughs. There are 48 acres of meadow. 2 knights hold 2 hides of this land, and have 2 ploughs there. TRE worth 8I; now 10I. Roger d'Ivry has it of the king.

# XVIII. THE LAND OF ERNULF DE HESDIN

In OFFORD CLUNY Bului had 10 hides to the geld. [There is] land for 10 ploughs. Ernulf de Hesdin holds it now of the king, and the monks of Cluny of him. There are now 5 ploughs in demesne; and 20 villans and 8 bordars having 5 ploughs. There is a church and a priest, and 2 mills [rendering] 50s, and 24 acres of meadow. TRE, as now, worth 10l.
