 and now in the occupation of one Thomas Bottell of Barnardiston aforesaid  
 his assignee or assignes Item I do give and bequeath unto Susannah  
 my said wife and to her heirs forever one piece of ground commonly  
 called or known by the name of Landes & Lyons and lyinge in Barnardiston  
 aforesaid and now in the occupation of one Thomas Hodges of London  
 above said his assignee or assignes Item I do give and bequeath unto  
 Susannah my said wife for and during the termes of her naturall life &  
 One & twentie with a yare termes and all other appurtenance unto her  
 same appurtenance and belonging as the same are situated lyinge and lyinge  
 in London aforesaid and now in the occupation of one William Ruggles aforesaid  
 his assignee or assignes Item I do give and bequeath the aforesaid land  
 with all the appurtenance thereto belonging after the death of Susannah  
 my said wife unto Francis Frost my youngest sonne and to his heirs forever  
 Item I do give and bequeath unto Richard Frost my eldest sonne now living  
 at such tyme as he shall be delivered unto him by Susannah my wife at such tyme  
 as she in her discretion shall think most fitting and convenient Item I do give  
 and bequeath unto Robert Frost my second sonne now living twenty pound  
 of lawfull monie of England and one silver spoon to be paid and delivered  
 unto him by Susannah my said wife at such tyme as he shall be delivered unto him by  
 Susannah shall think most fitting and convenient Item I do give and bequeath  
 unto Susannah living my eldest daughter twenty pound of like lawfull  
 monie of England and one silver spoon to be paid and delivered unto her by  
 Susannah my said wife at such tyme and tyme as she in her discretion shall  
 think most fitting and convenient Item I do give and bequeath unto Margaret  
 Frost my second daughter twenty pound of like lawfull monie of England  
 and one silver spoon to be paid and delivered unto her by Susannah my  
 said wife at such tyme and tyme as she in her discretion shall think most fitting  
 and convenient Item I do give and bequeath unto Peter Frost my sonne  
 in law and Mary his wife and my daughter according unto my promise made  
 unto them upon conclusion of marriage betwixt them the summe of forty pounds  
 of lawfull monie of England and one silver spoon to be paid and delivered  
 unto them by Susannah my said wife after my death at such convenient  
 tyme and tyme as she in her discretion shall think most fitting and  
 convenient Item I do give and bequeath unto Richard Frost my grandchild  
 and sonne unto Robert Frost my eldest sonne doteased and summe of five shillings  
 of lawfull monie of England to be paid unto him by Susannah my said wife  
 at such a convenient tyme as she shall think most fitting And if it shall come  
 to pass that all or any parte of the aforesaid and bequeathed legacy or  
 severall summes of monie aforesaid or any parte or partes thereof  
 shall be unpaid at or after the death of Susannah my said wife then that the

and my said wife shall by foyzed and poffeffed of the fame on any part or part all  
thereof then my will and meaneing is and I do hereby give them in fact much of  
them as at futh time shall re maine unfefted as before and wife for many of my  
chilfren as shall then be living and whiche then shall not haue attained all and  
every parte of thair leuour to gaue by me hereby given and bequeathed unto  
them and lastly I doo give and bequeath unto Elizabeth my wife all my perfonall  
estate doble moveable gode and whatsoevon wherofover they or any of  
them be, willing her to pay my debt proouid this my will and Coflament and to god  
my dearely loued Chns & the said Richard first doo make her the said Elizabeth  
ffrof my wife sole Executrix of this my last will and Coflament in witness  
whereof I haue set to my hand and ſignd this day and yeare above written.

Ann Thompson her markes.

nominate ordaine and make full and sole Executrix of this my last will and Coflament  
in witness whereof I haue hereunto set my hand and ſignd this day and yeare abovesaid  
in the presence of John marks of Elizabeth King. Gilbert Longe John Sonnes an  
Ann Thompson.
