Item I doe give unto my grandchilden Mary and Eleanor Herbert a hundred pounds a peece to be paid unto them at their severall ages of one and twenty yeares or within three monthes next after the day of their marriage provided always that they the said Mary and Eleanor shall marry with the consent and approbation of their father and mother otherwise to be void of none effect. Item I doe hereby make constitute ordaine and appointe my beloved Sonne Charles Herbert to be my sole executor of this my last will and testament. Item I doe make constitute ordaine and appointe Thomas Gutterman of the Barrow in the County of Wintonia Clerk and Christopher Sabage of Wintonia Habill in the County of Wintonia gent to be my overseers of this my last will and testament And I doe hereby revoke and disannul all and every other former testaments willed legacies and bequests by me in any wise before this day made named willed and bequeathed In witness whereof I the said Eleanor Herbert have hereunto put my hand and Seale the day and year first above written at Amoye Dominij 1602 Eleanor Herbert Sealed and delivered in the sight and presence of Christopher Sabage Thomas Gutterman and every her marks ~ ~ ~ ~ ~

 year after my decease I give and bequeath unto my wife and her daughter
 Grace Clarke five pounds to be paid within halfe a year after my decease
 I give and bequeath unto the poor people of Great Paxton five pounds for a
 down stocke and the interest to be paid amongst them the three firste
 day of March every year I give and bequeath unto Matthew Gerson a
 my brother John Gerson his sonne five and forty pounds to be paid him after his
 his fathers and mothers decease and the interest to his father and mother to be paid to
 during their and either of their naturall lives I give and bequeath un-
 to Matthew Dowden the sonne of my sister Anne Dowden five and forty
 pounds to be paid him after his fathers and mothers decease and the inter-
 est to be paid to his father and mother during their and either of their na-
 turall lives I give to Thomas Gerson his daughter forty shil-
 lings I give to Thomas Gerson his daughter forty shillings to be paid them
 within a year after my decease I give to Matthew Dowden my best
 doublet and a pair of shertes and a bolster and pillowe and all other my
 household stuffe to be equally divided with my brother John Gerson and sister Anne Dowden except one booke called Maldonate
 upon the Evangelist which I give to my loving friend William Gony of
 Efford day I give to Bartholomew Dowden my horse I give to
 shute and appointe William Gony of Efford day gentleman Richard
 Allen of great Paxton gentleman Obidiah Coysh of Epon gentleman
 and Alban Throgmorton of Efford day gentleman supervisors of
 this my last will and testament and doe give to either of them forty
 shillings a piece to buy either of them a ring And all the rest of my
 goods and mony by debt and legacy discharged I give unto
 whom I make sole executor of this my last will and testament except
 my wearing which I give to my brother John Gerson and my sister
 Anne Dowden and he desire ten pounds to be bestowed at buriale I
 desire whome I have hereunto set my hand and Seale this
 present third day of September 1659 Matthew Gerson Subscribed

A Codicill Nuncupative to be added to the

last will and testament in writing of Matthew Gerson late of great
 Paxton in the County of Huntingdon deceased bearing date the third
 day of September in the year of our Lord 1659 followeth to wit

Memorandum that the said Matthew Gerson
 deceased having made his will in writing and therein left a space
 for the nomination of his executors did severall times after the
 date of the said will declare that Mr Alban Throgmorton and
 Mr Obidiah Coysh should be his executors and more especially

on or about the eight day of November in the year of our lord 1662 be-
ing of perfect mynd and memory with a serious intention legall
to wit the said will declare that he had made his will in writing and
that the same was in the hands of Mr Albion Throgmorton and that in
the same there was a blank left for the nominating of executors therein
and therefore he did declare that the said Albion Throgmorton and Mr
Obadiah Corsh should be executors of his said will and that the said
will should stand and that the nomination of the said executors together
with the said will should remain and be his full and entire will and
testament All this before mentioned in whose names are hereunder writ-
ten do on the seventh day of November 1662 attest Margarett

begotten and for want of such heirs to the use of my grandchild William Dubber
and to the heirs of his body lawfully begotten and to be begotten and for want of
such heirs to the use of my grandchild Thomas Dubber and to the heirs of his
body lawfully begotten and to be begotten and for want of such issue to the use
of my grandchild Samuel Dubber and to the heirs of his body lawfully begotten
and to his heirs and assigns forever And my will is that my daughter in law Will-
iam Morgan and her wife and their heirs immediately after my decease
